The services of the National Mediation Board (NMB or Board) were invoked by the International Association of Machinists & Aerospace Workers, AFL-CIO (IAM) on November 30, 2005, to investigate and determine who may represent for the purposes of the Railway Labor Act (RLA), as provided by Section 2, Ninth, thereof, personnel described as “Customer Service Agents,” employees of Saudi Arabian Airlines Corp.

At the time this application was received, these employees were unrepresented.

The Board assigned Investigators Eileen M. Hennessey and Kendrah L. Davis to investigate.

Subsequently, the IAM filed a letter with the NMB which stated, “The International Association of Machinists and Aerospace Workers (IAM) hereby withdraws its application for investigation of a representation dispute in the above-referenced matter.”
