The services of the National Mediation Board (Board) were invoked by the Virgin America Pilots Association (VAPA) on August 10, 2012, to investigate and determine who may represent for the purposes of the Railway Labor Act (RLA), as provided by Section 2, Ninth, thereof, personnel described as "Pilots," employees of Virgin America Airlines. (Carrier).

At the time this application was received, these employees were unrepresented.

The Board assigned Investigator Norman L. Graber to investigate.

Subsequently, VAPA filed a letter with the NMB withdrawing its application for Investigation of a Representation Dispute in case number R-7333.

On the basis of the letter of withdrawal referred to above, the Board dismisses the application and closes its file subject to Part 1206.4(b) of the NMB's Rules.
