DISMISSAL-WITHDRAWN DURING INVESTIGATION

The services of the National Mediation Board (NMB or Board) were invoked by the International Brotherhood of Teamsters (IBT) on May 28, 2013, to investigate and determine who may represent for the purposes of the Railway Labor Act (RLA), as provided by Section 2, Ninth, thereof, personnel described as "Mechanics and Related Employees," employees of American Airlines. (Carrier).

At the time this application was received, these employees were represented by Transport Workers Union of America (TWU).

The Board assigned Investigators Maria-Kate Dowling and Norman L. Graber to investigate.

Subsequently, the IBT filed a letter with the NMB withdrawing its Application for Investigation of a Representation Dispute in case number R-7365.

On the basis of the letter of withdrawal, the Board hereby dismisses the application and closes its file subject to part 1206.4 (b) of the NMB Rules.
