DISMISSAL-WITHDRAWN DURING INVESTIGATION

The services of the National Mediation Board (NMB or Board) were invoked by the Transportation Communications Union/IAM (TCU) on June 27, 2014, alleging a representation dispute under the Railway Labor Act (RLA), as provided by Section 2, Ninth, thereof, among personnel described as "Customer Service Representatives," employees of New Jersey Transit. TCU indicated that it already represented employees in the craft or class of Clerical, Office, Station and Storehouse Employees and sought to accrete the employees at issue.

The Board assigned Angela I. Heverling to investigate. Subsequently, TCU filed a letter with the NMB withdrawing its Application for Investigation of a Representation Dispute in File No. CR-7127.

On the basis of the letter of withdrawal, the Board hereby converts this matter to NMB Case No. R-7405 and dismisses the application.
