The services of the National Mediation Board (Board) were invoked by the CWA/IBT Association on May 31, 2016, to investigate and determine who may represent for the purposes of the Railway Labor Act (RLA), as provided by Section 2, Ninth, thereof, personnel described as "Central Baggage Recovery Officers and System Support Coordinators," employees of American Airlines, Inc. (Carrier).

At the time this application was received, these employees were unrepresented.

The Board assigned Investigator Cristina Bonaca to investigate.

Subsequently, on March 1, the CWA/IBT Association filed a letter with the NMB withdrawing the petition for representation.

On the basis of the letter of withdrawal referred to above, the Board hereby converts this matter to NMB Case No. R-7477 and dismisses the application.
