Grievance Arbitration: Fee is \$950.00 per day for hearing and for research and preparation of the opinion and award. A hearing is any portion of a day up to eight (8) hours. Time for research is prorated.

Cancellation Policy: If the scheduled hearing is postponed or cancelled with notice of less than three (3) calendar weeks (or twenty one days), the per diem rate for each day of the scheduled hearing will be charged.

Interest Arbitration, Fact-finding and Labor Mediation: Fee is \$1200.00 per day for up to eight (8) hours. Time for research and preparation is prorated.

Travel Time: The Arbitrator charges per diem fee for any portion of a travel day up to eight hours on non-hearing days. The fee is prorated.

Expenses: Charges are made for actual cost of necessary and reasonable expenses, including airfare, car rental, food and lodging, etc. Automobile mileage is charged at the applicable IRS expense rate.
