 - RE: Status of Funding for Fiscal Year 2010

At the present time, Congress has not passed an appropriation for the National Mediation Board (NMB) for Fiscal Year 2010. The NMB is presently operating under a continuing resolution which expires on October 31, 2009.

All arbitrators are notified that no funds will be authorized for travel for the month of October.

The NMB will make every effort to authorize some days that may be utilized for decisions in accordance with the NMB's policy for the past three fiscal years. However, these authorizations will be made with minimal advanced notice. These days may be used for hearing cases if no travel is involved.

The Anti-Deficiency Act precludes arbitrators from hearing cases for free. Since the continuing resolution expires on October 31, 2009, arbitrators do not have any authority to schedule cases past this date if the cases involve the expenditure of funds by the NMB.
