

## **JACK GALLAGHER, ESQ.**

### **LABOR AND EMPLOYMENT ARBITRATOR**

Jack Gallagher was a Partner in the Employment Law Department of the Washington, D.C. office of Paul Hastings, LLP, a major international law firm, from 1991 until his retirement in 2013. At Paul Hastings, Mr. Gallagher represented employers on all aspects of labor and employment, including EEO litigation, collective bargaining, litigation, labor issues in bankruptcy, and arbitration. His clients were large employers, primarily in the airline and railroad industries, but also including large retailers. Since 2013 he has served as an Adjunct Professor at the Dickinson School of Law, Penn State University, in Carlisle, PA., where he teaches Labor Law, Employment Discrimination Law, and Survey of Employment Law.

**Arbitration Experience.** Mr. Gallagher has served as lead counsel in more than 100 arbitration cases, including contract interpretation and discipline cases. Among the many large and complex cases he has handled are: American Airlines-APFA Interest Arbitration (1994-95); Delta Air Lines-ALPA 9/11 Force Majeure Arbitration (2003); Northwest Airlines-ALPA 9/11 Force Majeure Arbitration (2003); Northwest Airlines-AMFA SARS Force Majeure Arbitration (2004); Delta Air Lines-ALPA Bankruptcy Interest Arbitration (2005-06); American Eagle-ALPA Scope Clause (3 cases).

**Academic and Professional Credentials.** Mr. Gallagher graduated from the Cornell Law School, with distinction, in 1972. At Cornell, he was a member of the Cornell Law Review and Order of the Coif. Following law school, Mr. Gallagher served as law clerk to Judge Aubrey E. Robinson, Jr. of the U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia (1972-74); as a Teaching Fellow at Boston College Law School (1974-75) and as an Assistant Professor at Indiana University School of Law (Indianapolis) (1975-76). In May 1976, he joined the Washington, D.C. office of Akin Gump Strauss Hauer & Feld as an Associate; he became a Partner in that firm in 1979 and remained there until his move to Paul Hastings in 1991. Mr. Gallagher was elected to the College of Labor and Employment Lawyers in 2004. He has been named to the Best Lawyers in America since 2003 and was listed by the Washington Post in 2013 as one of the Top Attorneys in Washington, D.C. He is a member of the D.C. bar.
