The services of the National Mediation Board (Board) were invoked by the Brotherhood of Locomotive Engineers and Trainmen (BLET) on May 12, 2025, to investigate and determine who may represent for the purposes of the Railway Labor Act (RLA), as provided by Section 2, Ninth, thereof, personnel described as “Train and Engine Service Employees,” employees of South Kansas and Oklahoma Railroad.

At the time this application was received, these employees were unrepresented.

The Board assigned Investigator Eileen M. Hennessey to investigate.

FINDINGS

The investigation established that BLET has failed to support its application with the required number of authorizations from employees in the craft or class as set forth in Part 1206.2(a) of the Board's Rules.

Therefore, the Board finds no basis upon which to proceed in this matter and the application is hereby dismissed, subject to Part 1206.4(b)(2) of the Board's Rules.
