The services of the National Mediation Board (Board) were invoked by Edward H. Bauer (Individual) on January 8, 2026, to investigate and determine who may represent for the purposes of the Railway Labor Act (RLA), as provided by Section 2, Ninth, thereof, personnel described as "Train and Engine Service Employees," employees of Missouri Eastern Railroad.

At the time this application was received, these employees were represented by the International Association of Sheet Metal, Air, Rail and Transportation Workers (SMART).

The Board assigned Investigator Andres Yoder to investigate.

FINDINGS

The investigation established that the Individual has failed to support his application with the required number of authorizations from employees in the craft or class as set forth in Part 1206.2(a) of the Board's Rules.

Therefore, the Board finds no basis upon which to proceed in this matter and the application is hereby dismissed, subject to Part 1206.4(b)(2) of the Board's Rules.
