The services of the National Mediation Board (Board) were invoked by the American Train Dispatchers Association (ATDA) on July 22, 2026, to investigate and determine who may represent for the purposes of the Railway Labor Act (RLA), as provided by Section 2, Ninth, thereof, personnel described as "Train Dispatchers," employees of Union Pacific Railroad Company (Carrier).

At the time this application was received, these employees were unrepresented.

The Board assigned Investigator Andres Yoder to investigate. Subsequently, on September 1, 2026, ATDA filed a letter with the Board withdrawing its Application for Investigation of Representation Dispute in R-7689.

On the basis of the letter of withdrawal, the Board hereby dismisses the application. Due to the unique circumstances of this case, the application bar at Part 1206.4(b)(3) of the Board's Rules does not apply to the dismissal.
